- II. Donna Howard, Saved by Grace shared that they have expanded to Camden County. Currently their office is Brunswick, as well as their men's only shelter. The shelter can accommodate 13 men who are able to work. While there is shelter in Glynn County for the homeless, one of which is operated by Saved by Grace, there isn't any place in Camden that even offers someone a place to shower or wash a load of clothes. For the time being, those who are homeless will be able to receive assistance in obtaining an ID, birth certificate, Social Security card, food stamp benefits, possible VA benefits, as well

They have currently helped 27 families, 159 total individuals, 103 females, 55 males, 91 adults in Camden. Their goal for the families is become sustainable.
